The Alameda County Health Care for the Homeless program (ACHCH), a federally-funded health center program housed in the County of Alameda Health Care Services Agency, is writing to express our deepest thanks, and acknowledge receipt, for your donation of \$2,013.54 on June 5, 2020.

In accordance with the terms of your donation, the funds were used for the purchase of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and other vital supplies to support the Health Care for the Homeless COVID-19 response. The supplies purchased included masks, hand sanitizer, gloves, and face shields to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 and keep our frontline workforce safe.

We are happy to inform you that these funds were fully utilized by ACHCH and have been very helpful in our health center efforts to control the spread of COVID-19 among people experiencing homelessness in Alameda County.
